Brown Dog Coalition's mission is to help one life at a time, because every life matters. We primarily save dogs and cats from an overcrowded southern shelter, but also help animals in New England. In addition to love and basic veterinary care, Brown Dog provides spay and neuter surgeries for every rescued animal, heartworm treatment, and other lifesaving medical care as needed. Our rescue and spay/neuter initiatives provide an immediate and long-term positive impact on animal welfare.

About Us

Brown Dog Coalition is a registered 501(c)3 foster-based animal rescue based in Hopkinton, MA that has been finding loving forever homes for abandoned companion animals since 2016. We have adopted out dogs who are now members of local families, and also dogs who have become service dogs, therapy dogs and a police dog.

As of January 2020:

- Over 1,000 dogs and cats have been adopted out in New England
- Over 30% of animals we help have received lifesaving, special medical care including...
 - o Amputations and other leg surgeries
 - Treatment for gunshot wounds, gashes, emaciation, fractured bones, spinal shock, parvovirus, mange, heartworms, embedded collars, infections and more
 - Emergency c-sections for pregnant dogs
